BEFORE INSTALLATION

Order identity	Confirm T8461 and the installed hardware revision before selecting a replacement.
Condition and handling	Reject damaged housings or bent pins. Apply ESD controls; do not open the housing.
Power arrangement	Separate backplane power from field power; check the load on every power group.
Cable and termination	Match the approved FTA/VFTA and Companion Slot or SmartSlot cable.
Maintenance control	Verify approved isolation, commissioning and changeover procedures.

PREPARATION AND BOUNDARIES

- The documented cable-key positions for T8461 are 1, 5 and 7. Confirm both strips for a Companion Slot cable.
- Use the complete connector table and circuit drawing. Unused outputs require the specified off command and termination; this summary is not a wiring diagram.

INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING

01	Confirm that the cable assembly is seated and the selected I/O slot matches the controlled configuration.
02	Open both ejectors with the release key. Guide the module into position and press the upper and lower fascia to seat it.
03	Lock the ejectors. Stop and inspect if the module resists insertion; never force a connector or straighten bent pins.
04	Verify field supply, group connections, channel loads and line-monitoring settings against the approved circuit documents.
05	For online replacement, use the configured transfer procedure and confirm active/standby indications before removal.
06	Validate output commands, field voltage and current, line diagnostics and event reporting before return to service.

SAFETY AND FINAL CHECKS

- Investigate field wiring and module faults separately using the published maintenance guidance.
- The complete manufacturer manual and plant safety procedure govern all live work and proof testing.

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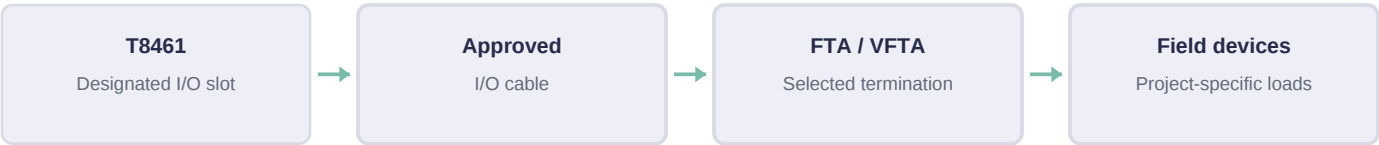

Logical field-connection path. Select the cable and termination assembly from the manufacturer documents; lines do not assign electrical terminals.

B | MECHANICAL KEYING INDEX

Number index only - NOT the physical connector orientation.



HIGHLIGHTED KEY PIECES: 1, 5, 7

The OEM instruction identifies these mechanical key pieces for removal. Match the real cable to the original figure before work; these are NOT electrical signal pins.

For Companion Slot cables, verify both keying strips. This index does not show cable orientation, signal pins or field-wiring connections.
