BEFORE INSTALLATION

Exact hardware	Record T8151, revision, serial number and firmware; retain the full suffix if present.
Manual scope	Match firmware to Issue 26 scope or the earlier manufacturer document it specifies.
Port connections	Confirm legacy Ethernet media, serial electrical modes and the actual adapter.
Chassis position	Use an approved I/O position; peer-to-peer requires the controller chassis.
Condition and ESD	Avoid exposed pins; reject damaged housings or connectors without repair attempts.

PREPARATION AND BOUNDARIES

- Use the controlled T8153 or TC-305-01 connection drawing. Do not wire from a generic interface diagram.
- Check mechanical keying against the exact module and cable. The current key-number example is labelled T8151B and is not reproduced as a T8151 instruction.

INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING

01	Check the actual hardware and firmware, maintenance isolation plan, adapter and designated chassis position.
02	Verify the cable is correctly seated. Open both ejectors using the release key and guide the module into the intended slot.
03	Seat the upper and lower fascia and close both ejectors. If resistance is abnormal, withdraw and inspect; never force insertion.
04	Match Ethernet media and rear serial modes to the approved configuration. Do not assume a later 100BaseT interface.
05	Check protocol roles against firmware scope. Open Modbus TCP slave service differs from the adapter-dependent RTU master service.
06	Verify interface health and required external communications through the approved commissioning procedure before service release.

- Do not treat a connected Ethernet cable as proof of a valid protocol configuration or successful data exchange.
- This reference supplies no terminal assignments or permission for live work; retain all controlled manufacturer safety instructions.

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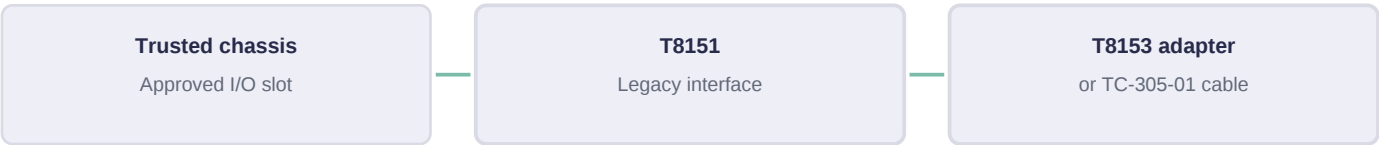

Original Amikon illustrations based on the cited OEM pages. Logical arrangement only; not to scale and not a manufacturer installation or electrical wiring drawing.

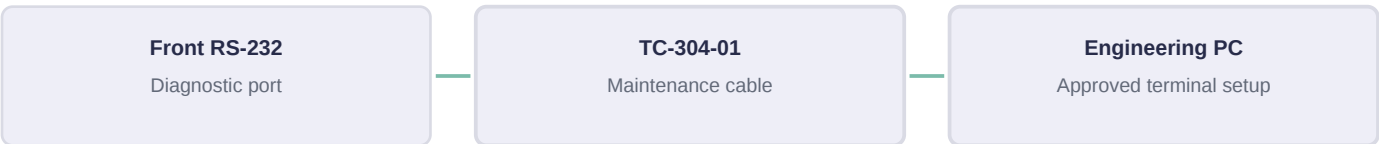
A | EXTERNAL COMMUNICATIONS PATH

B | DIAGNOSTIC AND CONFIGURATION CHECKS



Firmware determines which configuration instructions apply. Issue 26 names its supported builds and directs firmware through version 2.04 to Issue 6.

No key numbers or electrical pins are assigned here. The current manual labels its key-number example T8151B; verify exact T8151 keying before installation.
