BEFORE INSTALLATION

Exact identity	Confirm T8312-7, the 7-connection requirement and the actual hardware series.
Chassis and interface	Match the rear T8100 connection assembly and installed T8311 expander interface.
Cabling	Use the specified TC-301-01 cable and the complete ODU/SK1 connector tables.
Safety and condition	Follow site isolation and hazardous-area requirements. Use static precautions; do not touch exposed pins or dismantle the unit.
Connection record	Record the numbered expander connections and match the approved chassis addressing and configuration.

PREPARATION AND BOUNDARIES

- This is a connection and inspection checklist, not a complete installation procedure. Use the controlled manufacturer and site safety instructions.
- Do not infer permission for energized disconnection from the retaining clip. Qualified personnel must apply the original explosion-risk warning.

INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING

01	Verify the complete adapter identity, required number of connections and installed chassis/interface combination.
02	Record each numbered expansion cable and its destination before disturbing the installation.
03	Apply the approved isolation and hazardous-area procedure. Use static-handling precautions and inspect connector condition.
04	Fit the adapter to the documented rear chassis connection assembly and check the clip retention. Do not force or dismantle it.
05	Reconnect the specified communications cables to the recorded ODU positions and verify their locking features.
06	Check the approved chassis addressing and expansion communications before returning the equipment to service.

SAFETY AND FINAL CHECKS

- Use the original ODU and SK1 pin tables; the logical illustration is not an electrical wiring diagram.
- Check the complete expansion configuration through the qualified maintenance procedure; this summary does not authorize bypassing a safety function.

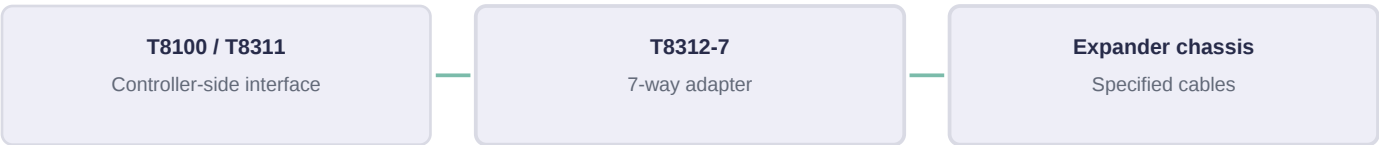

A | EQUIPMENT ARRANGEMENT



The 7 numbered ODU connectors connect the approved expander-chassis cables. Preserve their recorded destinations.

Use TC-301-01 communications cable and the original connector tables. The adapter clips onto the rear chassis connection assembly.

B | CONFIGURATION BOUNDARY

Preserve the required port count, coating option, connector arrangement and approved expansion configuration. A similar enclosure does not establish equivalent capacity or unrestricted substitution.
