BEFORE INSTALLATION

Exact identity	Confirm T7411, the supplied revision and installed module records.
Field power	Verify the documented 15-80 V DC field-power arrangement.
Switch wiring	Identify the sensor arrangement and matching line monitor device.
Configuration	Review thresholds, input names and line-fault alarm variables.
Safety plan	Use qualified personnel and the approved maintenance and isolation plan.

PREPARATION AND BOUNDARIES

- Select the complete OEM drawing for single or redundant field switches and modules; no universal pin map is supplied.
- Check the installed slot and application configuration against controlled records before removing a module.

INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING

01	Verify the field-power source and common return against the original input wiring and approved site drawings.
02	Select the line monitor device for the actual sensor and module arrangement; position it at the field switch.
03	Confirm slot polarization and exact module identity against the controlled Regent + Plus installation records.
04	Review input thresholds against the original field circuit, including any approved intrinsic-safety barrier arrangement.
05	Configure separate input and fault variables, and retain the required line-fault alarms in the application logic.
06	Validate input state, line-fault reporting and the intended redundant behavior using the approved commissioning procedure.

SAFETY AND FINAL CHECKS

- Review module active, power and fault indicators alongside each input and line-fault indication.
- Disabling a front-panel line-fault indication does not stop the diagnostics; verify controller fault variables and alarm handling.

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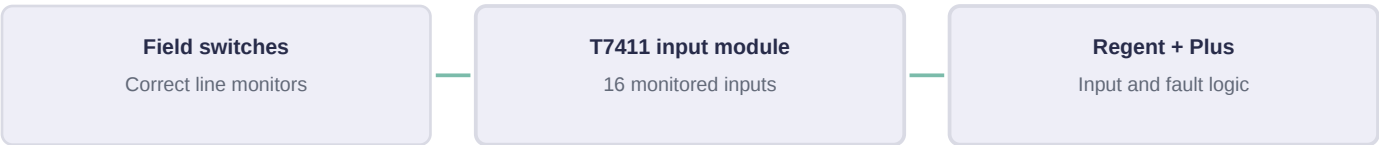
